Driveway Weather Guide and FAQ's

At Black Earth Pavement we take extra care when it comes to weather. We use our best judgement when it comes to dealing with rain and are in contact with our crews about any changing situations throughout the day. If we need to call the crews off for rain, we will notify everyone scheduled as soon as possible with a new rain date.

Q: Is my driveway okay to be sealcoated & crack filling if it rained yesterday?

A: The cracks are what need to be 100% dry for the crack filling material to go down. If we are able to crack fill prior to any rain, we are able to sealcoat the driveway if the surface is wet, as the sealer is water based.

Q: Can I power wash my driveway before the crews come?

A: Yes, we just ask that any power washing be done at least 1 week prior to your scheduled date

to ensure the cracks are thoroughly dry.

Q: Why did the crew come by and only fill the driveway cracks before incoming rain?

A: Crack filler is not affected by rain, whereas the sealer needs time to dry before rain.

Q: What happens if it rains a day after my driveway is sealcoated and crack filled?

A: The sealer only needs a few hours to initially dry and not be affected by the rain. We still ask

that you keep the vehicle off for the full 24-48 hours for proper cure time of the materials.
